Ted Walker on Rink2 was unable to repeat his recent success as skip but was well in contention when 8-6 up on the 8<sup>th</sup> end. Unfortunately they conceded 17 shots whilst only scoring 4 shots in the final ends, finishing 12-23 down. Scoring a five at the 9<sup>th</sup> end put Jeff Bizzell's triple in a 13-8 lead but could only find one more shot in the remaining nine ends whilst their opponents found thirteen shots to secure a 14-21 win. Dougie Mustoe was 6-6 at the 9<sup>th</sup> end but then found themselves 7-11 down at the 14<sup>th</sup> end. Pulling back to 10-11 at the penultimate end then have two shots against on the final end so losing 10-13. Tim Jolley stepped in as skip on Rink5 where they just rolled over their opposition 1-1 at the 2<sup>nd</sup> end then became 13-1 at the 5<sup>th</sup> end. They conceded a single at the 6<sup>th</sup> end but then went marching on to be 34-2 at the 16<sup>th</sup> end but then dropped two at the 17<sup>th</sup> which was erased by taking four shots on the final end resulting in a 38-4 victory and not surprisingly the pens.

Final shots scored was 74-61 but one winning rink and three losing rinks can be considered as a draw overall.
