Picking up a single at the 13th end and then a five at the next end they finally went in front 15-14 at the 14th end but were brought back to parity at the 15th end. Three-shots to one-shot on the final three ends secured a very close 18-16 win. Seven-shots at the 6th end put Steve Gould 11-5 in front where they remained just exchanging single shots up to the 14th end where they were at a 15-10 advantage. Nine-shots to one-shot on the final four ends resulted in at 24-11 win. On Rink4 John Hurren gave the first shot to their opposition but then nothing until the 13th end where three-shots away gave a score of 22-4, no more shots away and scoring nine-shots over the remaining ends gave John's triple a final score of 31-4 and, not surprisingly, the pens. Rink5 saw a close final score game with Tim Wilkins going from 11-3 up at the 9th end then 17-8 at the 16th end to then drop five-shots on the last two ends but held a safe enough margin to end 17-13 winners.
