Steady scoring without much reply gave them an incredible 26-5 score at the 12<sup>th</sup> end to then achieved a 30-9 win. Bob Parker on rink5 went to a 10-3 score at the 8<sup>th</sup> end but then seven shots against over the next four ends tied the game at 10-10 on the 13<sup>th</sup> end. Fortunately Bob's four took five shots to one shot on the final ends and won the game 15-11.
