Recovery by taking 13-shots on the next four ends put them 17-14 up but an unfortunate five shots against at the 15th put the score back in the opponents favour but two singles put the game at 19-19 going to the last end where two shots against gave a 19-21 result. A seven-shot gain by Steve Gould's triple on Rink6 at the 4th end put them 10-1 up and this advantage increased with a four at the 6th end, then continued throughout to put the score 17-6 at the 12th end. Eight shots to four over the remaining ends gave them a comfortable 25-10 win and the pens.
