Rink3 saw Tim Stacey go from 10-2 up at the 8<sup>th</sup> end to then only pick up 2 shots to the opposition picking up 15 shots on the remaining ends and lost out 12-17. Steve Gould on rink4, after picking up a 5 on the 4<sup>rd</sup> end and a 4 on the 4<sup>th</sup> end, never looked back and continued picking up shots without conceding many, ending up 28-10 victors.
