On a lovely green to bowl on we were treated to a lovely afternoon of bowls and hospitality on our visit to Teignmouth Britten Park; a green that is a credit to those who maintain it.

Tim Stacey on Rink1 moved into a 15-6 lead at the 11th end then equalled the opposition scores on the remaining ends and finished 20-12 winners. John Hurren's four picked up a six on the 4th end to be 8-1 up then carried on by taking 18 shots to 8 shots and ran out 26-9 victors and winning rink.
