On a lovely green to bowl on we were treated to a lovely afternoon of bowls and hospitality on our visit to Teignmouth Britten Park; a green that is a credit to those who maintain it.

Tim Stacey on Rink1 moved into a 15-6 lead at the 11<sup>th</sup> end then equalled the opposition scores on the remaining ends and finished 20-12 winners. John Hurren's four picked up a six on the 4<sup>th</sup> end to be 8-1 up then carried on by taking 18 shots to 8 shots and ran out 26-9 victors and winning rink. On rink3 Ron Taylor had a very even competition which was 13 each at the 12<sup>th</sup> end but then they were one shot down at the 14<sup>th</sup> which was cancelled with 6 shots to 1 shot on the final four ends to finish 20-16 up. Steve Gould on Rink4 was 5-0 up on the 3<sup>rd</sup> end but were then pulled back to 5-5 at the 7<sup>th</sup> end from which they moved forward to be 14-6 up at the 14<sup>th</sup> end; to then finish 17-12 winners. From being 7-3 up at the 7<sup>th</sup> end Trevor Wakeman's four were pulled back to 7-9 after dropping 5 shots at the 9<sup>th</sup> end and, although 9-10 down at the 12<sup>th</sup> end, they then only took 1 shot to their opponents taking 10 shots on the remaining ends to lose out 10-21. An even game at the start for Brian Clark on Rink6 saw them pick up 5 shots at the 5<sup>th</sup> end to be 7-3 in front and never looked back running out 20-8 victors.
